

General Rules and Regulations

Code of Conduct

Individuals and organization participating in the Hometown Hero Holiday festival Warner Robins Christmas Parade are expected to perform courteously, in good taste, and with safety in mind at all times during the assembly, execution, and dispersal of the parade.

Distribution of Materials

No candy, samples, or materials of any kind can be thrown or tossed from the units while on the parade route. Unit members walking near the crowd along route line may hand out items.

Vehicles

Drivers of ALL vehicles in parade must have valid driver's license, have proper proof of insurance as required by state law, and be at least 18 years of age.

Alcoholic Beverages The consumption of alcoholic beverages by ANY participant is strictly PROHIBITED

Parade Movement

Please keep a safe distance from the unit in front of you. ALWAYS keep moving. There will not be a point designated for performances. The parade should continuously be moving.

NO PYROTECHNICS of any kind are allowed on the float or in parade.

MUSIC should not be disruptive to the audience or other participants. Please have consideration for other units with music in the parade. The Parade Marshals reserve the right to control the level and type of music coming from your unit.

Please remember to dress in clothing appropriate to that season and bring water to stay hydrated!
